- Puget Sound Ecosystem Gallery: Marvel at and gently touch the real grey whale skeleton or turn to our first-of-its-kind
 interactive digital exhibition on whale migration in the Pacific Ocean. Build model ecosystems in our augmented reality
 sand table or investigate the detail of local fauna and flora with durable digital microscopes.
- Imagine Worldwide Distribution Gallery: Send packages up and down chutes while learning how goods are transported all around the world, providing a cutting-edge introduction to geography and our globally connected economy.
- Art Hangout: Develop creative skills and express yourself with art materials that you may not find at school or at home.
- **Tinker Shop:** Spend special time together in a workshop with real tools, offering a magical space for mentorship and the development of self-confidence, problem solving and creativity.
- Engineer It! Learn about the design process, and experiment with various engineering challenges in a 15' wind tunnel.
- Import, Export, Our Port: Imagine being the captain of a tugboat, guiding the biggest of ships through our port waters.
